Retraction: Roy Thurik, Anis Khedhaouria, Olivier Torrès, Ingrid Verheul, “ADHD symptoms and entrepreneurial orientation of small firm owners”, *Applied Psychology: An International Review*, 2016, 65(3), 568-586: <https://doi.org/10.1111/apps.12062>. The above article from *Applied Psychology: An International Review* published online on 16th February 2016 in Wiley Online Library (wileyonlinelibrary.com) has been retracted. The paper has been retracted by full agreement between the authors, the Journal’s Editors, Ute Stephan, Nele De Cuyper and Tomoki Sekiguchi, and John Wiley & Sons. The retraction was initiated by the authors when they discovered that they were unable to recompute the reported link between ADHD and Entrepreneurial Orientation (EO) in Table 2 of their article. The authors have revisited the raw data and created a corrected data file for replication purposes. They did so in the context of a larger study exploring the link between ADHD and EO which led to richer and more robust results. This larger study has been accepted for publication by *Applied Psychology: An International Review* as a research note.
